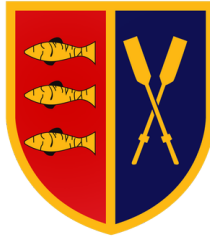

REGISTRATION

Please note that the CARA rules for checking in and registering scratched crews will apply; to avoid the fine all clubs should ensure that programme alterations are notified at least 30 minutes prior to the advertised start time. **Races are held under the rules of the Coast Amateur Rowing Association (CARA)** and all competing boats are expected to meet the minimum safety requirements laid down by CARA.

NOTICE TO CLUB CAPTAINS

- Late entries will be considered on the day. Late entries, scratchings and changes must be completed by **11:00 am**.
- Late entries will be charged at **£7** except junior races.
- The Regatta Committee will only reject entries for safety reasons, especially rowing and weather conditions on the day.
- Captain's Briefing will be by the Officials tent at **11.00 am**. Due to the nature of the course and the safe swimming zone implemented this year, all coxes are strongly encouraged to attend this briefing as well.

PARKING / STAGING

TRAILERS - PARKING

Trailers can be parked and unloaded from the South end of Beach House West Car Park. WhatThreeWords : <https://w3w.co/exit.tides.bowls>

Parking Permits will be given to towing vehicles and the Umpires cars only as we have limited spaces available. These permits are valid for Saturday 18th July 2026 only. Other cars can park in Beach House West Car Park but will be liable to pay for parking at the standard rates. **Under no circumstances are trailers allowed on the beach.**

TRAILERS - UNLOADING

Please take care when carrying boats from your trailers to the beach as you will cross a cycle lane on the promenade. Worthing parkrun takes place between 09.00 - 10:00 every Saturday morning. Please consider unloading boats after this. You may be asked to wait for a few minutes before crossing the promenade to allow runners and cyclists to pass if parkrun is happening. There will be both Marshals on the promenade to keep you, runners, cyclists and the public safe.

COURSE MAP

The course is straight and runs from the start / finish line opposite Splash Point (where Worthing Rowing Club is located) east for approximately 800m to the turns. The turns consist of anchored buoys with a large red flag on a 1.5m long pole. There are 10 turns. J14/J16 races will start at the turns. Marshalling of boats before individual races is carried out between the start / finish line and the pier. Please clear the course promptly after your races.

There is a 60m buffer between the coast and the course. Crews should not race within this buffer zone. There will be a red flag on a buoy at the finish line. All racing crews should cross the line on the outside of this buoy, or risk disqualification. This rule has been implemented to protect other water users and help prevent any incidents between racing crews and other water users. This means the first turn is over 60m from the shore.

- FIVE MINUTE RULE

All requests for Five Minute Rule must be made at the Captains' Briefing at the latest.



RACING SAFETY

Club Captains are to ensure that rowers are briefed on this event's risk assessment & safety plan prior to the regatta starting.

Captain's Briefing will be by the Officials tent at 11.00 am. Due to the nature of the course and the safe swimming zone implemented this year, all coxes are strongly encouraged to attend this briefing as well.

- ✓ Ensure no inexperienced crews or scullers go afloat who are not able to complete the course safely.
- ✓ Ensure no crews, especially novice crews, go afloat with inexperienced coxswains.
- ✓ Take care when launching boats and coming ashore, with bows always into the waves and lots of help in rough conditions.
- ✓ Exercise caution at the turns when approaching the turns and watching out for crews coming in if you are exiting the turns.
- ✓ Individuals are to be responsible for their own personal safety and to inform club captains if they do not feel safe to row. Club captains to ensure the welfare of their junior members during the whole event and ensure they are adequately looked after.
- ✓ Ensure rowers have plenty of fluids and protection from the sun to avoid sunburn or heat stroke.

The first aid point is located downstairs inside the clubhouse – please ask in there for help. Signs will be up regarding our Regatta Safety Plan and if a 999 call is required, please make it and get someone to advise the Regatta Organisers for onwards management. **A defibrillator is located inside the rowing club.**



HAZARDS

The Pier

Please be aware that rowing through the pier is **not allowed**. There will be anglers on the pier whose lines present a danger, so do not get closer than 30m to the pier. Avoid rowing too close to the pier as you will not be able to hear any instructions given over the PA.

Other Water Users

Note that there may be swimmers in the water on or near the course and small pleasure craft and fishing boats may cross or be on the course. There may also be paddle boarders heading out from the shore just east of the start line. The yellow buoys on the far side of the course indicate that motorised boats and jet-skis are allowed beyond this point. Whilst signage will be up during the day alerting these users, this does not remove the risk of an accident so stay vigilant.

Boating from the Beach

Some clubs will be boating from the beach adjacent to the course. Please do so in a thoughtful fashion. Avoid boating, when a race is in progress adjacent to you. Please boat when racing boats are at or near the turns and then clear the course as quickly as possible.

Note that there are also **groynes along the entire course**.

The Promenade

There is a cycle lane along Worthing Seafront, so please take extra care when crossing the cycle lane or walking along the prom.

BBQ

Trailer & Umpire Parking

Designated parking areas for club trailers and umpire vehicles. Please follow marshal directions when arriving and ensure all vehicles are parked safely and considerately.



REGATTA CONTROL:

Regatta Control is the central hub for race day administration. This is where crews go for scratchings, late entries, and to attend the captains' safety briefing. Prize giving will also take place here after racing concludes.



STAGING AREAS: The rowing boat icon marks the designated staging areas where clubs can set up and lay out their boats before racing. These zones are for rigging, preparation, and general boat storage during the regatta.



Toilets: Available at several locations along the seafront, including in Worthing Rowing Club, also near Marine Parade (Stop C, BN11 3PS) and within Beach House Park on Brighton Road (BN11 2EJ). These facilities are open daily during summer months, typically from 9am to 7pm, and include accessible options requiring a RADAR key.



AED: A defibrillator is located inside the club, in the erg room on the left as you enter through the garage doors.



First Aid: First aiders will be present either at the cake stand inside the club, or seated outside the club house with the first aid kit. Please speak to them for any first aid concerns.

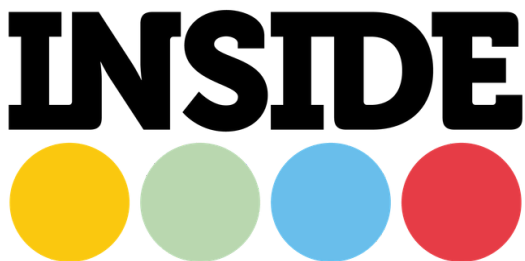
